For many years, since making these "Safe Birth Kits" available in the village of Jacquesyl, no mothers or babies have died during childbirth. If you would like to help, please prepare one or more kits with the items listed below and bring to our collection on the weekend of December 13-14.

Safe Birth Kit

To prepare a *Safe Birth Kit*, place the following items in a **gallon-size Ziplock bag**:

- One receiving blanket
- One large wrapped bar of soap (any brand)
- **Two pieces of string**, each approximately 8" in length, placed in an envelope

Financial donations are also welcome to complete the kits with medical supplies and to defray shipping costs. (Checks can be made payable to *St. John Parish* – please note *Haiti Marycare* in the memo.)
