


A MESSAGE FROM FR. ARTHUR

Life is always changing. The ancient Greek Philosopher, Heraclitus, said that life was like a river. Heraclitus concluded that nature is change and like a river, nature flows ever onwards. He noted that, if he initially jumped into a river, and then jumped into the river later in the day, he was not jumping into the same water.
